Lucie Dehli is a multidisciplinary French artist based in Belgium. She has been an artist and composer under the British label Somme Bizarre since 1990, with a career spanning across England, Europe, and Japan.

During one of her projects, painting became part of her artistic journey, and she has since practiced it deeply, developing her own visual language and writing, creating a bridge between these two artistic expressions.

She currently explores three main series in her work: one focused on abstract art, another centered on the free interpretation of characters, and a new series launching in 2025, titled *So that's called life*.





PEOPLE



The People series is created on sheets of recycled paper, sourced from recovered paintings. These sheets are assembled using paper tape to form a large-format surface. The visible, intentional construction becomes an integral part of the work, both as support and as trace of the gesture. Each piece is intended to be mounted on canvas."




